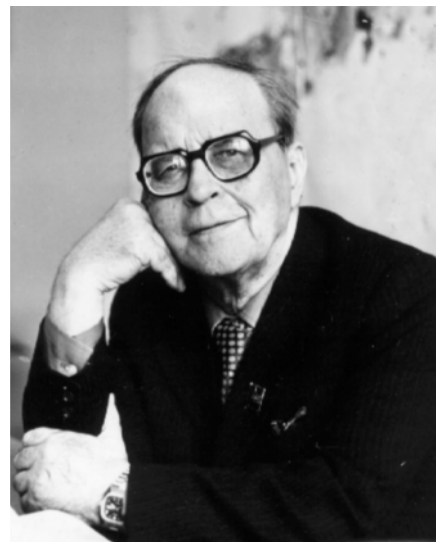

For the attention of the authors

Program of the Conference is compiled of abstracts, suggested to be recommended by the Organizing Committee. **Materials will be published in the author's version.** Authors are expected to submit no more than two abstracts. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to reject abstracts which do not correspond to the subject or are not prepared according to the author's instructions.

Instructions for submission of abstracts

The abstract should be no more than 4 pages in length including tables, figures and references. The abstract should be **obligatory** submitted in printed and electronic versions.

Electronic version: Electronic version should be submitted by e-mail as an attached file in Word (.rtf) format only.

Times New Roman font(Cyr), 10 pt size; is accepted, single-spaced; justified alignment, with hyphenation; indentation is 0.8 mm. Left and right margins are 4 cm, top and bottom margins are 5 cm.

Headings: 1) Author(s) Surname(s) and Initial(s) – Times New Roman font, 12 pt size, boldface 2) the Title – 9 pt size, boldface, in capitals; 3) Affiliation(s) – 9 pt size, in italics, 4) the text of the Abstract - two indents at the beginning; headings and subheadings – alignment: center.

The formulae are inserted in the abstract using Equation Editor.

Tables and figures are inserted in the text after citations. **Tables** include no more than one table, Times New Roman (Cyr) font, 9 pt size). **Figures** include no more than two *black-and-white* figures (*line art*). Captions are given after the figure (Times New Roman (Cyr) font, 9 pt size, alignment justified, with hyphenation).

In-text citations are usually numeric and parenthesized in square brackets. References should be given using Times New Roman (Cyr) font, 9 pt size.

to the Organizing Committee before April 1, 2011.**
