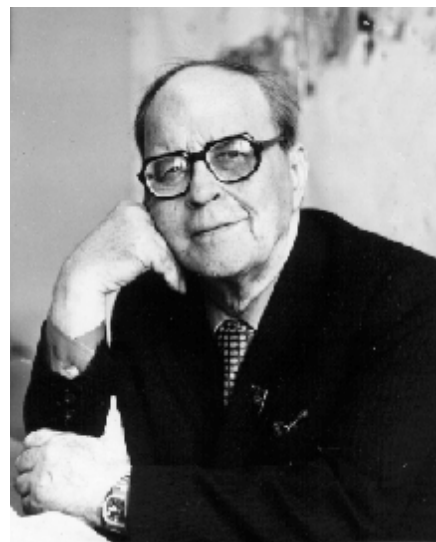

The **Conference Program** is compiled of abstracts, accepted at the discretion of the Organizing Committee. **Materials of the Conference will be published in the author's version.** An author may present no more than two abstracts. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to reject abstracts that do not correspond to the subject or are not prepared following the author's instructions.

Abstract Submission Instructions

The abstract should be no more than 4 pages including tables, figures and references. Submission in printed and electronic versions is mandatory.

Electronic version should be e-mailed as an attached MS Word (.rtf) Format file.

Font style: Times New Roman Cyr, 10 pt size. Single spacing; justified alignment with hyphenation, indentation of 0.8 mm.

Margin settings: top and bottom 5 cm, left and right 4 cm.

Headings: 1) Author(s) Surname(s) and Initials Times New Roman Font, 12 pt size, boldface; 2) Title 9 pt size, boldface, in capitals; 3) Affiliation(s) 9 pt size, in italics; 4) Content of the Abstract: two indents at the beginning, center-aligned headings and subheadings.

The formulae should be inserted into your abstract using Equation Editor.

Tables and figures are inserted into the text after citations. **Tables** should include no more than one table, Times New Roman Cyr Font, 9 pt size. **Figures** include no more than two *black-and-white (line art)* figures. Captions are given after the figure (Times New Roman Cyr Font, 9 pt size, justified alignment with hyphenation).

In-text citations are usually numeric and parenthesized in square brackets. References should be given using Times New Roman Cyr Font, 9 pt size.
